The Technical Director of Footloose will facilitate the Directors artistic vision of the show through the design and execution of the set, lighting and sound plans.

Key Responsibilities:

- To abide by the By-Laws of Blue Canoe and the mandate to support youth arts, for those aged 30 and under.
- To create a detailed tech week schedule for the production
- To plan, schedule, and present technical designs to the production team (set, lighting, sound, special effects)
- To cooperate & collaborate with fellow technical team members and oversee technicians.
- To work closely with the Managing Director to ensure the safety and technical efficiencies of the production.
- To work closely with the Managing Director and stage management team to plan and adhere to deadlines.
- To carry out any technical tasks not completed by technicians including setting up sound systems, hanging/focusing lights, hanging masking, programming cues, etc.
- To attend regularly scheduled production team meetings as well as additional meetings when requested by the Managing Director and/or General Manager
- To understand and ensure that Blue Canoe values are instilled in each interaction.



- To maintain order within Blue Canoe rented spaces (e.g., office, storage, venues etc.).
- All other job duties as assigned by the Managing Director and/or General Manager.
